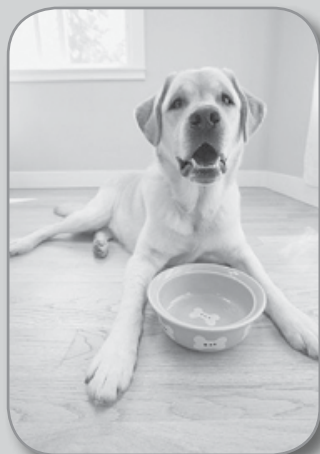
PANDA

My name is Token

Someone allowed this handsome Chesapeake Bay retriever to roam loose on a golf course. He had no tags, no microchip and now a search is on for a lifetime commitment with a new guardian.

When he came to the Humane Society of the Desert, he was very weary, emaciated and scared. You could see the fear and uncertainty in his eyes.

He was given a warm welcome from our staff, some tender loving care and a wonderful meal. The next morning an employee noticed Token was very listless and there was excessive drooling. He was immediately rushed to Palm Spring Animal Hospital for treatment. It was first determined that he had eaten something toxic and was given medication.

As his condition did not improve, Token underwent emergency surgery to see if there was a blockage in his stomach. There was no blockage,



but it was determined that Token has an inflammatory bowel condition that can be controlled with the proper nutrition. He has to be fed hypoallergenic wet and dry dog food and this will keep his condition under control. This food is prescription only and is very expensive.

As you can see from the photo's, Token has quite a large surgical scar on his stomach, but he is convalescing and will make a full recovery in the near future.
